Note:- Before taking further action for inspection, the VT members & Representatives of the above Institutions are requested to read the following instructions carefully.

2. As you are aware that the NCTE is a statutory body which was established under the NCTE act, 1993 for coordinated development of the teacher education in India as per provisions of the NCTE Act. The Visiting Team has a very important role to play in deciding the case of any of the institution which submits the application for grant of recognition to the NCTE. The statutory direction are to be followed by Visiting Team Members and as per direction of the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, I would request you to kindly visit the said institution as an expert member of the team so as to scrutinize & verify the infrastructure & instructional facilities created by the institution with a view to assess the level of preparedness of the institution and also to verify the infrastructural & instructional facilities as per the NCTE norms and standards to commence the course.
3. The VT shall prepare its own work schedule for the examination of documents, physical verification of facilities and interaction with different stakeholders. The Report shall also include the filled-up proforma submitted by the institution and fresh documents made available by it, if any. It should be ensured that each page of the filled in proforma as per provisions of clause 8 of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 is signed by the Head of the institution or an authorized representative of the Management of the institution, clearly mentioning the name and designation. The V.T. after receipt of the requisite original/authentic documents as per the application submitted by the institution alongwith other relevant documents as per proforma under clause 8 of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 from the institution, the inspection team is required to scrutinize, verify and assess the availability of infrastructural and institutional facilities and availability of the requisite staff (in case the same are appointed by the institution) as prescribed by the NCTE in its Norms and Standards for the programme as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations. It may be noted by the Visiting Team that all the latest norms & standards including NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations' as amended from time to time are available in the NCTE website namely www.ncte-india.org. The guidelines for filling up the VT proforma are enclosed with the VT proforma.
4. Inspection of above institution will be conducted between 18.01.2016 to 30.01.2016. VT members are requested to consult each other telephonically and by mutual understanding fix the date for inspection of the institution under intimation of the NRC, NCTE. A written intimation regarding the date of inspection may be faxed/e-mailed to this office shortly before moving for inspection.
5. It shall be taken into note by the institution concerned that it is the responsibility of the institution to ensure presentation of the original/correct/authentic figure & facts of the applications, land & building documents, infrastructure & instructional facilities to the Visiting Team. The land & building documents presented by the institution shall be issued by the competent authority as per the law of the State/UTs as the case may be. The same shall be as per the requirement of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations'. As per clause 8.(6) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 "The copy of the affidavit shall be displayed by the institution on its official website. In case, the contents of the affidavit are found to be incorrect or false, the society or trust or the institution concerned shall be liable for civil and criminal action a under the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code and other relevant laws, and shall also be liable for withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee concerned. (It shall be noted by the VT members and Management of the Institution that a copy of NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations and norms & Standards thereof are also available on the NCTE website www.ncte-india.org and also in the NRC website www.nrcncte.org.)
6. It shall also be noted by the above institution that as per provision of the clause 8(4) (i) "no institution shall be granted recognition under regulation, 2014 unless the institution or society sponsoring the institution is in possession of required land on the date of application. The land free from all encumbrances could be either on ownership basis or on lease from Government or Government institutions for a period of not less than 30 years." Also as per clause 8(4) (ii) "the society sponsoring the institution shall have to ensure that proposed teacher education institution has a well demarcated land area as specified by the norms. The teacher education institution shall not be allowed to have any other institution within its demarcated area or building and shall not have any other course (s) in its building."
7. The Visiting Team shall be solely responsible for scrutiny of application with reference to original documents and to verify the infrastructure & instructional facilities with reference to the provisions of the NCTE Rules & Regulations and norms & standards. The Visiting Team should assess & verify the availability of the sharing of common facilities like lab, library, size of common facilities, availability of land area, built up area, measurement of the rooms with reference to the building plan, whether the Institution is running composite programme or not, verification of the authenticity of the land documents, CLU, building related documents and non-encumbrance certificate. It should compulsory verify that the land &

building documents are issued by the competent authority as per the law of the State/UT as the case may be. The Visiting Team, therefore, has to verify and examine all the documents with the original with due diligence, Regulations, with recommendation whether to grant approval to run the course as sought by the institution, so that the same is place before the concerned Regional Committee for taking appropriate decision as per provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and NCTE Regulations, 2014 & norms & standards there under.

8. As per provision of Clause 7(8) of NCTE Regulation, 2014, at the time of the visit of the team of experts to an institution, the institution concerned shall arrange for the inspection to be videographed in a manner that all important infrastructural and instructional facilities are videographed alongwith interaction with the management and the faculty, if available at the time of such visit. The visiting teams, as far as possible, shall finalise and courier their reports alongwith the video tapes on the same day.

Provided that the videography should clearly establish the outer view of the building, its surroundings, access road and important infrastructure including classrooms, labs, resource rooms, multipurpose hall, library etc. The visiting team shall ensure that the videography is done in a continuous manner, the final unedited copy of the videography is handed over to them immediately after its recording and its conversion to a CD should be done in the presence of visiting team members:-

Provided further that at the time of inspection for new courses or enhancement of intake of the existing course, the visiting team shall verify the facilities for existing teacher education courses accorded recognition by National Council for Teacher Education and would ascertain the fulfilment and maintenance of Regulations and Norms and Standards for the existing courses as well.

9. The VT Proforma and NCTE regulations 2014 with relevant norms and standards are handed over to Dr. Rajendra Singh (Retd. Principal) for necessary suitable action as per provisions under section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993. A copy of NCTE Act, Rules & latest Regulations and norms & Standards thereof are also available on the NCTE website www.ncte-india.org and also in the NRC website www.nrcncte.org.

10. In addition to verifying the correctness of all the important documents from the original and verifying the fact that the same has been issued by the authority competent to issue the same as per the prevailing rules of the State/UT/the Central Govt. as the case may be, the VT is required to obtain following documents from the Management of the institution as per the applicability as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations:-

- **Building completion certificate (Format enclosed)**

Note: As per clause 8(7) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 "At the time of inspection, the building of the institution shall be complete in the form of a permanent structure on the land possessed by the institution, equipped with all necessary amenities and fulfilling all such requirements as prescribed in the norms and standards. The applicant institution shall produce the original completion certificate issued by the Competent Authority, approved building plan in proof of the completion of the building and built up area and other documents to the visiting team for verification. Not temporary structure or asbestos roofing shall be allowed in the institution, even if it is in addition to the prescribed built up area.

- **Essential data sheet to be submitted by the institution as per provisions of clause 7(7) and 8(5) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (Format enclosed)**

11. In view of above, you are requested to conduct physical verification of the infrastructure & instructional facilities of the institution as per provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 and norms & standards three under. The VT members are required to submit the report (No column of the report proforma should be left blank and columns not applicable should clearly be indicated and strike off and further each page to be duly signed by both members). The VT in its report should specifically mention whether the institution fulfils all the criteria as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and norms & standards there under or not (copy of the norms & standards is enclosed). Therefore, the VT is required to submit the following documents:-

- (i) VT Report duly filled in as per the proforma enclosed alongwith Building Completion Certificate.
- (ii) CD as per clause 7(8) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014
- (iii) Final check list on the basis of complete scrutiny of application & essential data sheet as per clause 7(7) and 8(5) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 to be submitted by the institution at the time of the institution & verification of the infrastructure & instructional facilities created by the institution for the course applied for as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

- (iv) Essential data sheet to be submitted by the institution as per provisions of clause 7(7) and 8(5) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 to be submitted by the Institution.

12. The Visiting Teams shall finalize their reports along with the VCD/CD on the same day and the same shall be dispatched to the Regional Director, NRC, NCTE on the same day in order to place the same before the NRC for suitable decision as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations in a sealed cover on the same day on completing of inspection failing which the responsibility shall be of VT only.

13. TA/DA/Honorarium and other expenses related to your stay shall be borne by NRC, NCTE as per rules (copy enclosed). As such, the inspection team members should not accept any gift, hospitality, TA/DA etc. offered by the Institution. Any violation of this instruction would not only debar the inspection team member from undertaking any inspection further on behalf of NRC/NCTE and other action would also be initiated against the visiting team members as per law.

14. The members of Visiting Team (VT) are requested to enclose a photocopy of this letter alongwith your TA/DA bills duly signed by you to facilities payment on time.


